Claims against instructors and interns involved in sports and recreation can result in costly lawsuits. Even if the claim is groundless, legal defense costs can be astronomical. Therefore we strongly suggest that you bring the availability of this coverage to the attention of all instructors and interns connected with your organization.

Description – This policy will be issued on an occurrence basis, including the significant provisions:

- (a) Policy limit includes defense outside the policy limit, investigative and all other related costs.
- (b) Policy limit is a per occurrence limit.
- (c) Sponsoring organization is not an additional named insured.
- (d) There is no deductible for liability insurance coverage.

A choice of liability limits – Choose from two per occurrence policy limits - \$1,000,000 or \$500,000. (You may select different amounts for each individual, if needed.)

Coverage Period – Coverage will be in effect for a period of one year from the day following the date the application and payment are received and approved by K&K, or on a later date as specified. When applying online, coverage will be in effect from one year of the specified effective date.

What is covered – This policy covers:

- Actual or alleged negligence by the insured recreation employee or commissioner while acting within the scope of their duties granted to them by the sponsoring organization
- Work at recreation centers and playgrounds, parks, swimming pools, ice and roller rinks, day camps, team sports, arenas and stadiums, golf courses, zoos, organized trips and tours
- False arrest, detention or imprisonment, or malicious prosecution, libel, slander or defamation of character
- Invasion of privacy, wrongful eviction, or wrongful entry

Who is covered – Individuals who are eligible for coverage under this policy include:

- Professional and non-professional recreation and park department employees
- Volunteer recreation, park and playground workers
- College students majoring in the field of recreation
- Individual members of NRPA
